Kevin Bilger became Vice President, Lockheed Martin Space Systems Company in April 2016. Previously, he was Managing Director of AWE plc, AWE. Prior to assuming that key leadership position in October 2014, Bilger was vice president of Programs and Quality for Lockheed Martin Space Systems Company.

In January 2009, Bilger became vice president and general manager of Global Communications Systems for Lockheed Martin Space Systems Company. In this role, he led an award-winning team responsible for delivering the nation's premier military communications systems and commercial communications satellites for international customers. Other key executive leadership positions with Space Systems have included: vice president of Programs; vice president of Subcontract & Product Management; vice president of the Space Based Infrared System; vice president of Military Space Programs; and vice president of Engineering.

Bilger began his service with Lockheed Martin in 1982, as a summer intern. He earned a bachelor of science degree in chemical engineering from the University of California, San Diego, and a master of science degree in materials science and engineering from Stanford University. He is also a Sloan Fellow graduate from Stanford University, earning a master of science degree in management.

Bilger is a senior advisor for Industry Initiatives for Science & Math Education in Silicon Valley, and served on the board of directors for Ronald McDonald House. He is an American Institute of Aeronautics & Astronautics Associate Fellow and member of the Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers.
